



ARCH399 SUMMER PRACTICE I _CONSTRUCTION SITE – Assessment Guideline

Assessment

Assessment is based on the following criteria:

- 1) Student Evaluation by Company Supervisor (SE)

- 2) ARCH399 Summer Training Report (STR) (**%100** of total grading)

STR should contain the following in a comprehensive manner:

a. Descriptive information about the construction site; construction team and its organization; construction equipment

b. Daily Work-Log

Information about the construction process to be documented at least twice a week
Personal evaluations on both the construction and training processes

STR will be evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:

Quality of Written Documentation (**35%** of total grading)

Quality of Visual Documentation (**%65** of total grading)

Architectural drawings of the construction site; site photographs documenting daily process;
all the visual documentation of your contribution and evaluations

Grading:

In order to successfully complete ARCH 399 **Summer Practice I_Construction Site**, students must receive at least 3 points from 1.c and 1.d of SE, and complete minimum of 10 points in total from SE. Students who fail to do so are considered as “Unsuccessful” and receive F letter grade at the end of the semester. Students who are “Successful” (who receive at least 3 points from 1.c and 1.d of SE, and complete minimum of 10 points in total from SE) are eligible to submit their summer training report (STR). The STR grade, of which 35% comes from the quality of written documentation and 65% comes from the quality of visual documentation, constitutes the overall end-of-semester grade.

Letter Grades:

Students who are “Unsuccessful” by SE or STR receive U (Unsuccessful) letter grade.
